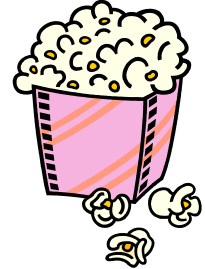

## RESIDENT CAMP NEWS

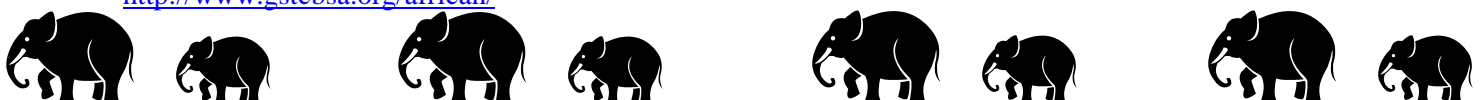
If you are attending Resident Camp at Munhacker and have NOT paid your second installment of \$80 (*it was due 1/17*), please see Michelle

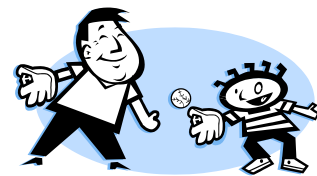
Den Leaders and Pack Committee meet monthly. Interested parents are welcome to attend these meetings.
